- 1. The minimum attendance requirements for students are as follows:
 - Students must attend classes regularly and maintain an attendance average above 80%.
 - Students who are more than 10 minutes late must wait until after break to enter class

2. The consequences for students who do not meet the minimum attendance requirements listed above are as follows:

- Students who regularly miss class may lose the right to attend the class they have been missing.
- Truant students must speak with the Director of Studies in order to be allowed to attend further classes.
- If a student is absent for more than 9 consecutive school days without notifying OIEG Oxford International Education Group – North America, they will be classified as having dropped out.
- Students who have less than an 80% attendance average may not receive a certificate
- 3. The process by which students must report an absence is as follows:
 - Adult students must contact the Director of Studies by email or call the school directly to inform the school that they will be absent.
 - Students wanting to take a vacation must submit a request 4 weeks in advance of the intended vacation start date and are subject to a change fee if they want to extend their studies to make up for their vacation time. Students may take a 2-week (10 business day) holiday for every 12-week term of study.

Minors 18 and under:

• Students must attend all classes unless they are ill. In the event of illness student's host family must call the school to notify the staff of their condition.
